

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2018

Kippa-Ring State School will receive

**\$200,743\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving an Upper 2 Band Writing result to in Year 3 from 16.7% (2017) to 25% and in Year 5 from 0.0% (2017) to 10% respectively.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or better in English from 62.3% (2017) to 70% (2018).
- Undertake the *Social-Emotional Wellbeing Survey* (ACER) with Years 5 and 6 students and using the results to target and evaluate support programs and initiatives.

## Our initiatives include

- Enhancing student writing outcomes by implementing our revised school writing program in a consistent manner. Writing is the prime focus for staff professional development, coaching and feedback.
- Building teaching skills and student engagement through the adoption of YuMi Deadly Maths (QUT *PRIME Futures* project). Focus on quality 'warm ups', number facts and 'hands on' learning.
- Supporting the provision of Play Group, to improve access to early learning/Pre- Prep experiences. Plan and promote community engagement in school activities.
- Implementing 'You Can Do It!' Program Achieve – social, emotional and academic achievement program supported by all staff, Community Engagement Teacher and whole school focus activities.
- Enhancing our oral language program with a strong focus on early intervention in Prep and Year 1.




